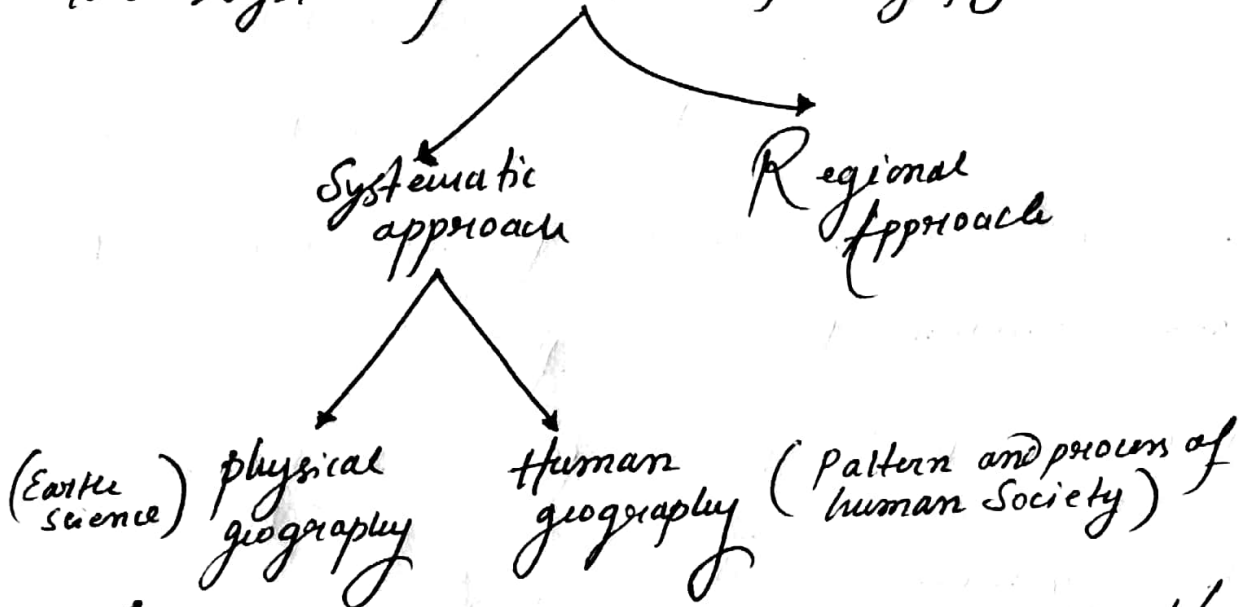

(Related to Human welfare)

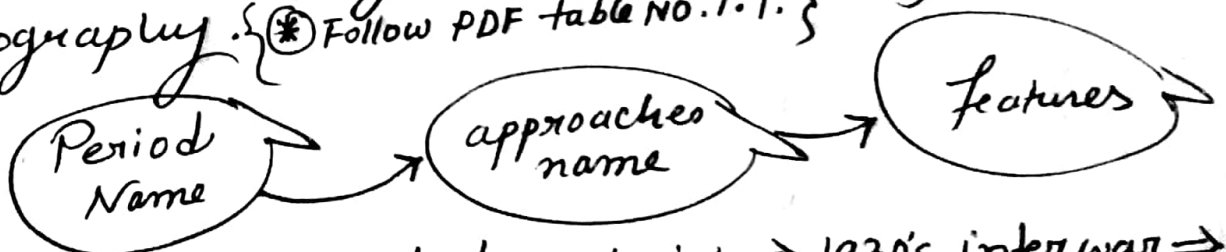
ii) Radical school of thought
